

BRC GLOBAL STANDARD FOR FOOD SAFETY ISSUE 8 WORKSHOP

OVERVIEW

The BRC Global Food Safety Standard Issue 8 was updated in August 2018. The Standard includes requirements for product safety, quality and operational criteria for legal compliance and protection of the consumer and has been approved by the Global Food Safety Initiative (GFSI) as a certification standard. This 3 day workshop provides a detailed interpretation of the standard. Delegates are guided through each clause of the standard using case studies and group activities to practise their understanding of the clauses and to ensure participation which will make the workshop more enjoyable for the delegates. A self assessment and a project plan for implementation of the requirements will need to be developed by delegates as part of the training course..
